We have 6 staff including the Centre Manager, Postal Manager, Program Coordinators, Finance Officer and a Trainee Finance Officer.









AN UPDATE FROM MINGENEW POLICE



Depot Hill Road Crash

At about 2:40 pm Friday 20 October 2023, a white Toyota Hilux tray-back utility was travelling towards Geraldton on Depot Hill Road, when about 5km East of Depot Hill, the vehicle left the road and rolled several times.

The 62-year-old male driver of the Toyota Hilux sustained life-threatening head injuries and was conveyed by helicopter to a hospital in Perth for medical treatment. He remains in a stable condition in intensive care.

The passenger, a 32-year-old man, was treated for minor injuries.

The incident was attended by St John Ambulance, DFES and Police from Mingenew, Dongara, Geraldton, Morawa, Perejori, Three Springs and Major Crash.

We want to thank the local community members who stopped to assist and the patience of those affected by road closures in the area.

Drink Driving

The impact and consequences of drink driving are well-publicised. Fines, loss of licence, injury, jail and death. Yet, rural communities, in particular, foster an acceptance of drink driving after a visit to the pub or social events.

Police within the North Midlands Hub have been working hard to discourage the behaviour. Twenty-three drivers have been caught across Mingenew, Morawa, Perenjori and Three Springs this year. But we know it's a drop in the ocean.

Some don't care. But for some, it becomes a child's game. Drink drivers will wait until one of their mates has been sacrificed to the cops before fleeing from the back car park. They'll endure small talk until the early morning hours, hoping the cops have called it a night. They'll persist, navigating the back roads for an extra 20 minutes to try and arrive home undetected.

But for 23 individuals this year, their avoidance tactics weren't enough. The majority had their licences disqualified on the spot.

We'll continue to do our best. But if you see your loved one or mate about to drink & drive, call them out on their behaviour. You'll never regret doing so, as much as you'll regret doing nothing.



Nominations are called for the Local Government Extraordinary Election to be held Wednesday, 13 December 2023, to fill the remaining (one) 4-year term vacancy.

Nominations open on Monday 23 October 2023 Nominations close at 4.00pm Monday 30 October 2023

Any person who is an Australian Citizen over the age of 18 years, who is an elector of the district and is not disqualified under the *Local Government Act 1995*, may nominate for Council.

Candidates are required to lodge with the RETURNING OFFER;

- A completed nomination form in the prescribed form, signed & witnessed. This form is available
 from the Shire or on our website.
- Complete the online Local Government Candidate Induction available at
 https://www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au/local-government/local-governments/council-elections/induction-for-prospective-candidates (reference number from completed induction is to be included on the nomination form)
- A single A4 page profile containing not more than <u>1,000 characters</u> of biographical information about the proposed candidate and statements of the candidate's policies or beliefs
- A nomination deposit of \$100 (cash, postal order or bank cheque)
- A recent passport size photograph (optional)

When an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation, signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered to 21 Victoria Street Mingenew, posted to PO Box 120 Mingenew or emailed to the Returning Officer at enquiries@mingenew.wa.gov.au and must be received by the close of nominations. Further information is available at www.mingenew.wa.gov.au/elections/.

Waitsia Gas Project Update

Early-stage commissioning activities have commenced at the Waitsia Gas Plant while gas plant construction is continuing, with the aim of optimising project delivery.

The primary goal of commissioning is to ensure the project that has been built will perform and operate as it was designed to do.

From November 2023, over a period of three to four months, it can be expected that there will be:

- Light from visible flaring while the safety system is tested and verified; and
- Noise as equipment is started and brought online.
