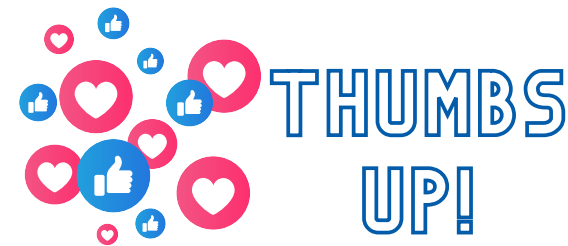

Have your say on MinRes' development application for our community!

What is the development application?

Public comment is being sought on a significant development application for gas extraction wellheads (within the Lockier, Yarragadee and Moorriary localities in the Shire of Mingenev), and a central processing facility (in the Mount Horner locality within the Shire of Irwin).

The \$850 million project is proposed to be developed by Mineral Resources Limited (MinRes), and also includes construction of a 24-bed operations workforce accommodation village.



Does the village benefit the community?

The accommodation village will be built about 18km west of Mingenev, next to the gas processing infrastructure, and also include a lounge for meal preparation and serving, recreation building, gym, vegetable garden, and playing fields.

On other projects, such as in the Shire of Ashburton, MinRes are building these facilities within the townsite.

As part of the Shire's Strategic Community Plan 2023–2033, Council promised to advocate to Government agencies for local housing to be included in operational approvals for resource sector projects.

Will there be any economic benefits?

The proposed development is estimated to create 350 jobs during the construction phase and 40 full-time, site-based staff once operational, with a preference for "suitably qualified" local residents.

The application has not explained the necessity for a FIFO camp considering the stated aim to prioritise the employment of local residents.

The Economic Benefit Statement shows an overall annual operations expenditure of \$26.5 million, less than 20% of which is slated to be spent within the Midwest.



You have until **April 18** to tell the Department for Planning, Lands & Heritage what you think about the development application.
