The Leading Hand Final Trim Grader Operator will be responsible for the day-to-day operations of the construction crew and will report directly to the Works Manager. This role allows for a certain amount of autonomy and will be a rewarding opportunity for the right person to build and run a dedicated road construction and maintenance team. It is desirable that the candidate has experience in final trim grading in local government and/or the civil construction industry and experience leading a team. The Shire will provide training and support to the right candidate with less experience but with leadership qualities and a willingness to learn. Applicants must hold a valid Driver's Licence (HR class minimum) and a WA White Card.
